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# Print And Mail Headlines For 2026

Stay updated on the latest print and mail news!

With the new year having just begun, many of our clients may be wondering if they'll see any changes to their operations.

That's why we at D4 Solutions put together the print and mail headlines that will impact you in the coming weeks:

## No USPS Market Dominant Rate Increases in First Months of 2026

The USPS has clarified that the beginning of the year will see [no rate increase for Mailing Services](#). This announcement was made in late September 2025.

Products falling under the Mailing Services category include Marketing Mail, Periodicals, Bound Printed Matter, and First-Class Mail.

The USPS's statement did leave open the possibility of a postage price change later in 2026. If that happens, D4 Solutions will communicate the update to our clients as quickly as possible.

## Price Change for Parcels Starting January

Shipping Services, on the other hand, [will see a price increase](#). The affected products include Priority Mail, Priority Mail Express, USPS Ground Advantage, and Parcel Select.

The price increases are as follows:

- +6.6% for Priority Mail.
- +5.1% for Priority Mail Express.
- +7.8% for USPS Ground Advantage.
- +6.0% for Parcel Select.

These changes will take effect on January 18th.

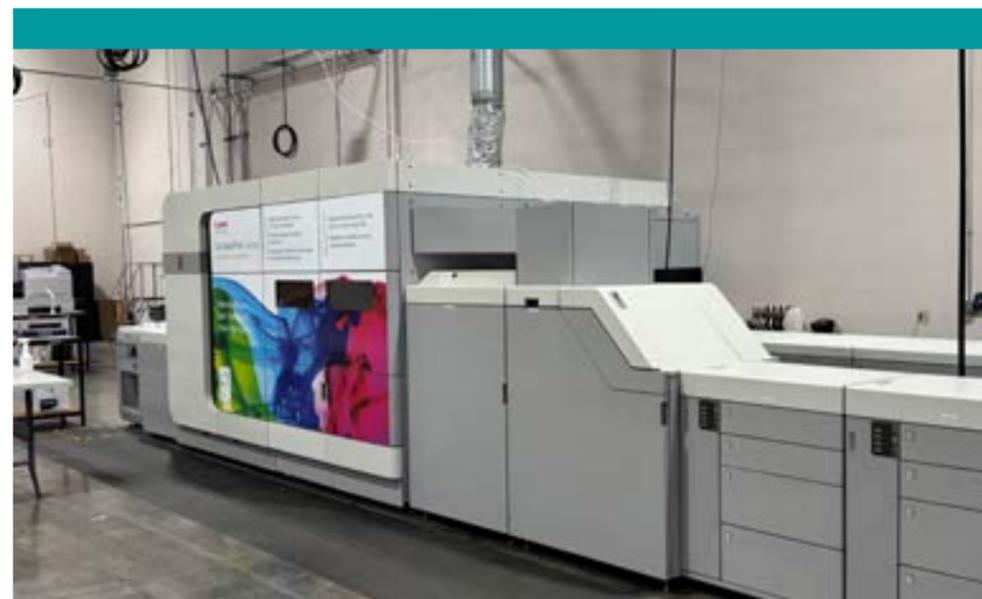
Kevin Zipsie, D4’s Vice President of Operations, touched on this when he remarked,

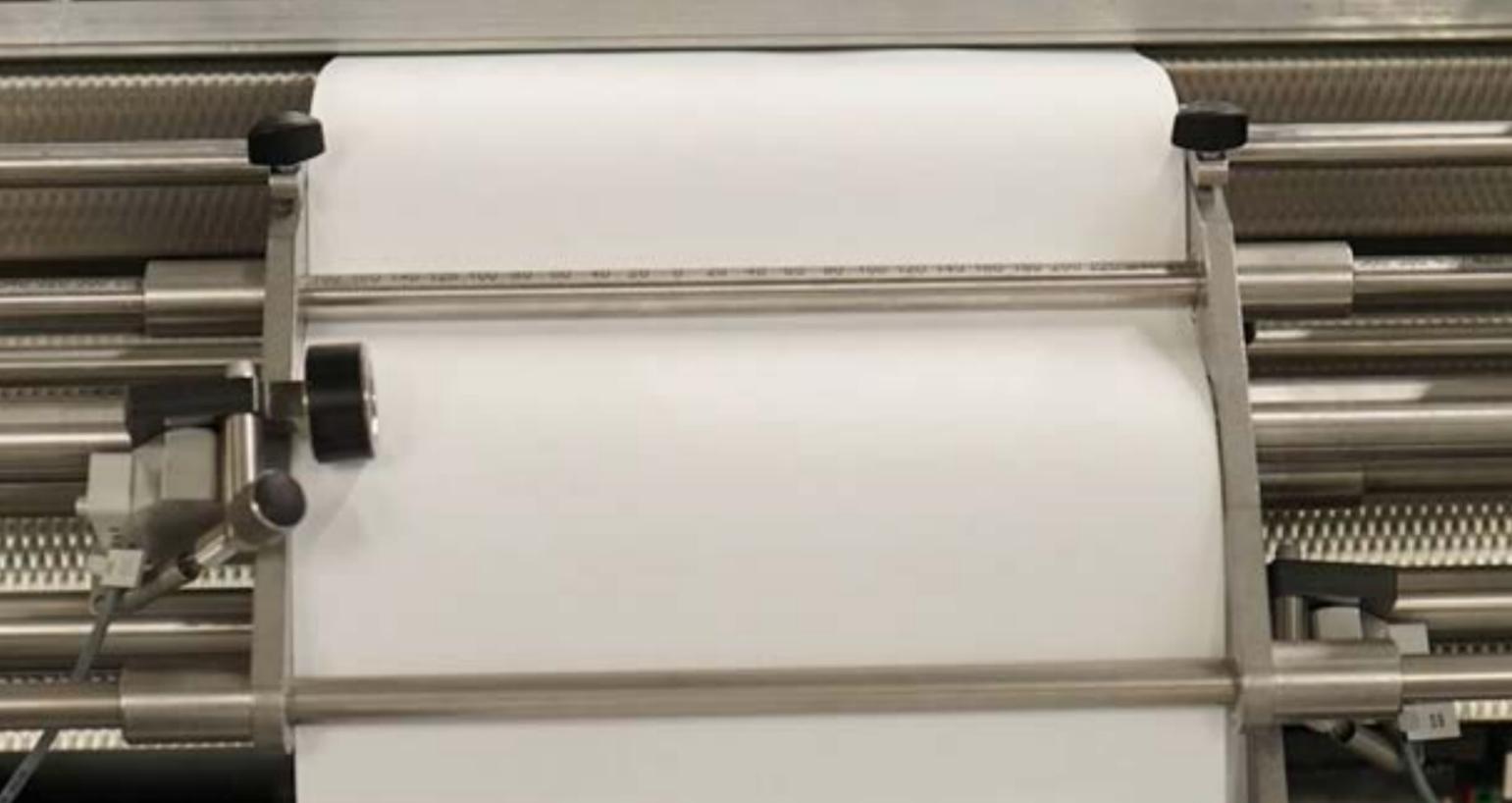

Welcome to Print Tips, where we share ways you can get more value out of your document production and distribution. From saving money to streamlining processes, D4 knows how to make print and mail operations the best they can be.

Without further ado, here are this issue's Print Tips!

### Take Advantage of CASS and NCOA

CASS allows you to standardize and correct address data. NCOA keeps track of every Change of Address request filed with the USPS, and you can use it to update your records. These two programs reduce undeliverable mail, limiting wasted postage and costs. They improve both delivery speed and USPS compliance.

D4 Solutions offers CASS and NCOA services. We return your original data files to you, along with a list of updates to make in order to remove outdated addresses

and standardize your records. If you're interested, talk to your PM or Sales Rep.

### Use Postal Promotions

USPS Postal Promotions reduce mailing costs. Talk to your PM or Sales Rep to see if you qualify, and to learn which promotions are currently active.

### Design PDF Files for Print Production

Following these formatting tips can help our operations team complete your print runs smoothly:

- Set your PDF color profile to CMYK. Our presses run in CMYK, so files submitted in this format require less conversion.
- Optimize and flatten your PDFs. Flattened files process faster on our presses.
- Use Pantone colors for brand logos. Pantones allow operators to make precise adjustments on printing equipment, giving you a better color match for your brand assets.
- Embed all fonts in your PDFs. This makes it easier to print documents with the exact fonts you request.

Here are the most recent changes:

### User Activity Logs

If you're a Portal admin, you can now manage your teams more effectively by employing user activity logs.

These records track:

- When users log in and log out.
- When passwords are reset by users or by an admin.
- When a team member has too many failed password attempts or tries to log in with invalid credentials.

User activity logs provide increased visibility into the Portal, and help you resolve issues faster. They're also a great tool to strengthen audit-readiness.

### Newest-First Sorting Order

All records now display the most recent activities first, so that you get the latest information as quickly as possible.

### Idle Timeout

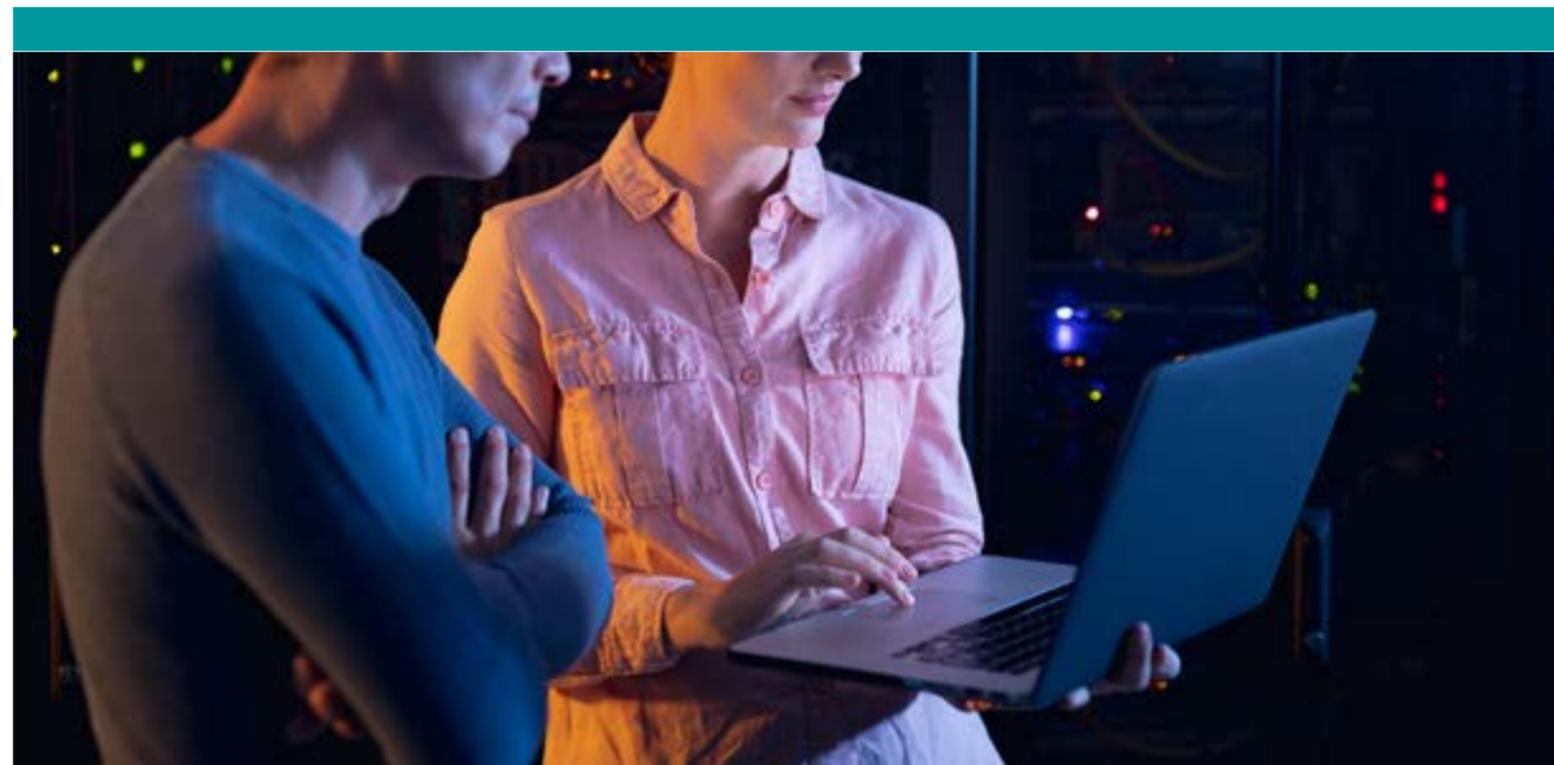
To enhance the security of the Portal in accordance with D4's standards, users are now automatically logged out after 15 minutes of inactivity.

You can set this timeout value higher or lower to meet your organization's needs.

### Navigation Tooltips

Move through the Portal easier! When you hover over any of our 5 navbar options, you'll now see a message telling you what the icon is for.

This improves usability for new and frequent users alike.

## Excerpt from ["What Do Secure Printing Solutions Look Like?"](#)

"How do you prove that customer information is being protected throughout the printing process? You can only do so if you know where each document is during all stages of the workflow. This is what chain-of-custody piece-level tracking

accomplishes. 2D barcodes are placed onto each mailpiece on the production floor. These barcodes are scanned during every step of the printing process, recording who accesses which documents, and when.

Piece-level tracking continues once mailpieces leave the print facility. At this stage, USPS intelligent mail barcodes, or IMBs, are attached to each envelope. IMBs are scanned throughout transit at facilities that have the right capabilities. Printing vendors offer access to web portals that record each barcode scan, providing easily accessible data on the entire process."
